Opening Discussion: Are you ready to make a bold move? What have you heard from God these last 3 weeks?

- 3) To go with God we must trust that he can supply our needs. How has God supplied your needs?
- 4) To go with God means we have to face our fears. What fears do you have to face?
- 5) To go with God we must treasure the invitation to join God. What has God invited you to be a part of?
- 6) To go with God we must be willing to go where we have not gone before. How will you stick with your bold move when the other side tells you to turn back?
- 7) What is your bold move?
